On February 17, 2016 the Cemetery Board Members agreed to allocate the following money:

Funds of FY17 from Perpetual Care for seasonal help and equipment through June 30, 2017 not to exceed \$120,000.

Funds from FY17 Sale of Lots for 3rd year lease payment (Schedule9) and the 1st and 2nd year lease payment of cemetery copier through June 30, 2017 not to exceed \$49,708.16.

Capital Improvements paid for by Perpetual Care not to exceed \$252,000.00 by June 30, 2018, which will include the following:

- i. Oak Grove Public tomb masonry repair
- ii. Rural Office repair/replacement of trim & siding
- iii. Rural Cemetery garage roof repair
- iv. Pine Grove Greenhouse garage roof
- v. Pine Grove maintenance building repairs
- vi. Pine Grove parking area paving repair work

Capital Improvements paid for by Sale of Lots, not to exceed \$169,000 by June 30, 2018, which will include the following:

- i. Purchase of 2 Black Suy for funeral processions
- Oak Grove-North fencing ii.

replacement

Oak Grove-South fencing iii.

replacement

Rural- Matthew St. fencing replacement iv.

V. Rural Cemetery water upgrades

vi. Pine Grove water upgrades

Purchase of 100 trees for Cemetery Grounds víi.

The meeting was called to order by Carol Grimes at 6:02 p.m. In attendance were Carol Grimes, Barbara McDonald, Steven Caton, Egidio Melo, Ronald Labelle, Sylvia Gomez-Turner, and Jeanne Safioleas.

There was no one in attendance for open session.

On a motion by Carol Grimes and seconded by Barbara McDonald, the minutes from the June 9, 2015 meeting were unanimously voted to approve and accept.

On a motion by Steven Caton and seconded by Egidio Melo, the certificates for June 2015 through January 2016 were unanimously voted to approve and accept.

REPORTS

6a) Commissioner's Report-

Mr. Ronald H. Labelle presented his Commissioner's report and discussed the following:

Pine Grove Cemetery:

New rows are being plugged to accommodate mausoleums in section 17 and 18 Premium. Maintenance building garage roof has been repaired but the heating system is failing. We are waiting on an estimate from Abreu Heating. Greenhouse windows need re-glazing in order to be more energy efficient. Garage doors need to be insulated or replaced.

Oak Grove Cemetery:

Fencing has been removed and we are looking to replace the rod iron gates with the original ones that were there. Garage doors need to be insulated or replaced.

Rural Cemetery:

New rows are being plugged to accommodate mausoleums in section 210 and D Premium. Maintenance garage roof needs repair as it is leaking very badly and the garage doors need to be insulated or replaced.

A presentation was given to the board members on Columbarium's, and discussions followed regarding our desire to either purchase or build them in our cemeteries.

St. Theresa's Church: An explanation was given to the board regarding what steps need to be taken now that the church is not selling and what our vision is for the land going forward.

On a motion by Barbara MacDonald and second by Egidio Melo the Commissioner's Report was unanimously voted to approve and accept.

6b) Financial Report -

Financial report was presented by Sylvia Gomez-Turner.

On a motion by Egidio Melo and seconded by Barbara McDonald, the Financial Report was unanimously voted to approve and accept.

- 8e) On a motion by Egidio Melo second by Barbara Mac Donald, it was unanimously voted to except all of the Capital Improvements proposed to be paid from Sale of Lots not to exceed \$169,000 to be completed by June 30, 2018, to include the following:
 - i. Purchase of 2 Black Suv for funeral processions
 - ii. Oak Grove-North fencing replacement
 - iii. Oak Grove- South fencing replacement
 - iv. Rural-Matthew St. fencing replacement
 - v. Rural Cemetery water upgrades
 - vi. Pine Grove water upgrades
 - vii. Purchase of 100 trees for Cemetery Grounds

On a motion by Egidio Melo and second by Steven Caton, Carol Grimes switched the position of Chair to Egidio Melo.

8f) On a motion by Carol Grimes and second by Steven Caton, it was unanimously voted to give Commissioner Labelle the authority and support needed to move forward with the process for the demolition of St. Theresa's Church.

Motion by Carol Grimes and second by Steven Caton, it was unanimously voted for Carol Grimes to resume as Chair.

8g) Motion by Egidio Melo and second by Barbara MacDonald, it was unanimously voted to lift the moratorium at Pine Grove Cemetery for section 18 Premium only, allowing Pre Need sales to increase revenue for St. Theresa's land development.

There was no executive session.
