Establishing a New Revolving Fund

The New Bedford Council on Aging Adult Social Day Program will be implemented on July 1, 2016 at the Brooklawn Senior Center. Participants will be referred by Coastline Elderly Services, Inc., the Association for the Relief of Aged Women (ARAW), and other agencies that serve seniors. The program will provide structured activities Monday-Friday from 9AM-3 PM. The cost is set by Medicare @\$35 per day, per participant. There is an additional fee for transportation (round trip home/center pick-ups): \$7 for New Bedford residents and \$10 for nonresidents.

Proceeds will be used for:

- Congregate lunches
- Morning and afternoon snacks
- Office supplies for the program
- Contracted vendors who provide health, wellness, education and exercise groups
- Arts & Craft Supplies, educational materials
- Printing/marketing supplies
- Furnishings/Equipment
- Program-related conferences and meetings
- Field trips
- Support staff salaries and wages

These items are all associated with the Adult Social Day Program whose revenues and amount limited to be spent in FY17 is restricted to revenue estimated at \$100,000 deposited into the fund.
