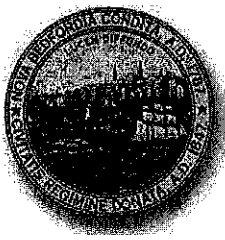

I am respectfully requesting that you recommend to City Council the appropriation of \$5,263.10 for the FY17 NB Energy Now (NBEN) Revolving fund.

This fund was developed to cover incidental costs of the energy residential outreach program and development. Currently, the Department of Public Infrastructure oversees the tracking of the fund.

FY16 revenue through June 30, 2016 is estimated to be \$520.00. FY16 expenses through June 30, 2016 are estimated to be \$4743.10. FY17 expenses would be on an as needed basis.
