AN ORDINANCE

RELATIVE TO THE USE OF MARIJUANA IN PUBLIC

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of New Bedford as follows:—

SECTION 1.

Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by inserting, after section 17-10, the following new section:-

Sec. 17-10.1 – Use of marijuana in public areas.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke, to consume, or otherwise use marijuana or prepare marijuana for any such use on any public way or area or way to which the public has right of access, or on any sidewalk appurtenant thereto within the city.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke, ingest, consume, or otherwise use marijuana or prepare marijuana for any such use in any motor vehicle while such vehicle is upon a public way or area or way to which the public has right of access within the city.
- (c) Whoever violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a criminal arrest and/or a fine as provided in section 1-9 of this code. The provisions of this ordinance shall also be enforced by criminal indictment or criminal complaint.
- (d) For the purposes of this section, the following definitions shall apply:
 - (1) “*Marijuana*,” has the meaning given “*marihuana*” in Chapter 94C of the General Laws of Massachusetts. The term “*marijuana*” as used in this section shall also mean “*tetrahydrocannabinol*” as defined in Chapter 94C of the General Laws.
 - (2) “*Smoke*,” the possession of a lighted or lighting of a cigarette, pipe or other product cigarette designed to be combusted and inhaled.

Section 2.

This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43 of the General Laws.
