

Union St Project & Free Cash Appropriation

The Department of Public Infrastructure respectfully requests your support in seeking City Council approval to amend the May 27, 2004 Council appropriation for Wastewater projects to include language which allows work to be done on the Union Street Sewer Separation Project and general system improvements.

The city has received a MassWorks grant in the amount of \$2,500,000 for the Union Street project. The total estimated project value is approximately \$5,000,000. There is roughly \$1,000,000 leftover from the Coggeshall Street SRF project, and DEP has already approved the use of these funds for Union Street, should Council be in agreement to amend the original order language. This leaves the project with a shortfall of roughly \$1,500,000.

We are proposing that a portion of the shortfall be paid from this year's free cash certification from Water. At this time, I would like to request your support in recommending to the Mayor the appropriation of \$1,000,000 from Water free cash to the Union Street project and the remaining \$1,008,667.00 to the established Water Stabilization Fund pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 40: Section 5B.

This still leaves an estimated shortfall of \$500,000, which we intend to procure from future years of the MassWorks grant. Please do not hesitate to contact me with questions or concerns.
