The Committee on Memorials & Dedications at a Meeting held on Tuesday, September 08, 2015, considered a Communication, Mayor Mitchell to City Council, submitting a request to rename a section of Massachusetts Route 18, from Elm Street to Cove Street, from "John F. Kennedy Highway" to "John F. Kennedy Boulevard", the purpose being to improve pedestrian access from our Downtown and South End neighborhoods to the Waterfront and to beautify the area.
