I am writing to inform you that at a meeting held on October 22, 2015, the New Bedford City Council Adopted a Written Motion, sponsored by Councillor Gomes, "Requesting, that the New Bedford City Council go on record in support of Governor Baker's proposed legislation aimed at controlling the Opioid epidemic and abuse; and further, that the City Council send a letter to our State Delegation and Senate President Stan Rosenburg supporting the Governor's initiative and legislation that includes a provision that would allow Medical Professionals to commit a person to a drug treatment facility for up to 72 hours if they pose a danger to themselves or others, along with a three-day restricted prescription for first-time users of this pain relief medicine."
