Dear Michael,

This is the annual letter regarding the EMS Detail Revolving Fund.

The purpose of this fund is to provide EMS providers with a pay rate when they are working details from third party vendors. The paramedic rate will be \$55.00 per hour and EMT rate will be \$40.00 per hour.

The estimated revenue for this fiscal year is \$ 25,000 for services we provide from third party vendors who have events in the City of New Bedford.

The amount estimated to be spent for FY24 will be \$25,000 which will be used to pay staff who work at these events.

The EMS Director has control over these funds. The EMS Department expends all funds in accordance with the procedures and practices of the Purchasing Department.
