

At your request, I am submitting the Health Department's Revolving Fund, which must be approved by the City Council for FY'17

Fund 1204 – Fines and Forfeiture Revolving Fund – Health

This fund was established so that health-related fines issued by the Housing Court could remain with the City (rather than being turned over to the State). Revenue into this fund varies on a case-by-case basis; the revenue collected comes in mainly as fines from lead violation cases. In FY'16, we have collected \$400.00 in revenue.

We do anticipate receiving an estimated amount of \$3,000.00 in revenue for FY'17 with expenses to be estimated at \$3,000.00 for the annual source replacement and shipping of our lead machine and constable services.

The Director of Public Health and the Board of Health have control over this fund.
