The Committee on Ordinances at a Meeting held on Monday, November 21, 2016, considered a Written Motion, Councillors Lopes, Bousquet, Martins, Winterson, Council President Morad, Councillors Carney and Coelho, requesting that the Committee on Ordinances review the City of Boston's Ordinance regarding Recreational Vehicles and further, that the Committee also review a draft Ordinance written by the Police Department for the City of New Bedford on Recreational Vehicles. On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Abreu, the Committee VOTED: To recommend to the City Council, AMENDMENT of the ORDINANCE, amending paragraph D of Section 1, Chapter 17 of the Code of Ordinances, by inserting a sentence relative to towing and storage fees resulting from impoundment.
