PROPOSED PARKING REGULATION

No vehicle shall be parked on any street within the city limits without a Certificate of Inspection or Certificate of Rejection as defined in 540 CMR 4.02.

No vehicle shall be parked on any street within the city limits if the Certificate of Inspection affixed to the vehicle has expired for a period of 30 days or more.

No vehicle shall be parked on any street within the city limits if a Certificate of Rejection has been affixed to the vehicle for more than 60 days.

It shall not be a violation of this section for any vehicle that is deemed by the parking clerk to be in compliance with the provisions of 540 CMR 4.00 at the time a violation is thought to be occurring.

Notwithstanding the provisions of section 23-47, the fine for any violation of this section shall be \$25 if paid within 21 days, \$35 if paid thereafter but before the parking clerk reports to the registrar, and \$50 if paid thereafter. Each day that a violation occurs or continues shall be considered a separate violation subject to the fines herein.

The provisions of this section shall otherwise be enforced pursuant to MGLA c. 90 §20A.
