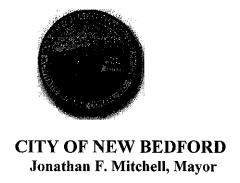

I'm writing to respectfully request a transfer to cover an anticipated deficit in our Highways 200 account.

We have an estimated surplus of \$200,000 in our 100 account due to vacancies. I am seeking a transfer of this \$200,000 from our 100 account into our 200 account to cover expenses associated with purchasing services which will allow the department to continue to provide adequate maintenance throughout the city. Costs associated with the Salt Shed construction and AECOM contract retainage from the RT18 Phase 1 project are among some of the unanticipated expenses that have created the need for this transfer.
