This letter is being written with an additional request for your assistance with the placing of Flags at gravesites to honor deceased Veterans for Memorial Day.

I am requesting your further assistance on behalf of the Commander of the Cape Verdean Veterans Organization. They are responsible for flagging approximately 1,450 Veterans graves at St. John's Cemetery on the New Bedford/Dartmouth line. The majority of the Veterans at the Verdean Vets are committed to maintaining the annual tradition of flagging graves of fallen comrades, the practice has become quite a task in light of the large number of graves that they are committed to marking.

It is with that concern, and with the knowledge of your commitment to our Veterans and the community-at-large, that I am requesting your assistance and the assistance of your prerelease work crews in marking these additional Veteran's graves this year.

The Veterans would like to arrange to schedule the work crews for the middle of the week of May 22-26 in order to allow sufficient time to complete the task, and be late enough in the week to discourage youths and vandals from removing the Flags prior to the Memorial Day Ceremonies.
