Please be advised that the Department of Facilities and Fleet Management is currently maintaining the Tangible Supply Disposition Revolving Fund.

The purpose of the of this fund is for recycling related initiatives and equipment and also the purchase of minor capital equipment in accordance with Massachusetts General Law Chapter 30B, Section 15.

The Department of Facilities and Fleet Management has taken in revenue totaling \$132,714.49 and expensed \$34,946.88 leaving a fund balance of \$97,767.61.

At this time I would like to request that this fund be set up in FY 18 with an operating balance of \$25,000.00.
