

Subject: FY18 - REVOLVING FUND APPROVAL

We submitted an Ordinance to the City Council for consideration at its April 12th meeting to establish Section 10-47 of the City Code – Departmental Revolving Funds.

This ordinance is required under the Municipal Modernization Act which became effective last year. The item is currently pending in Ordinance Committee.

As required by the Act, the Ordinance must specify the program or activities for which the revolving fund may be expended, the departmental receipts in connection with the program or activities, and the department authorized to expend from the fund.
