RE: QUEST CENTER REVOLVING FUND

Please be advised that the Department of Facilities and Fleet Management is currently maintaining the Quest Center Revolving Fund, which is located at 1213 Purchase Street, New Bedford, MA 02740.

The purpose of the Quest Center is to provide a focus on entrepreneurial training and location for business start-up activities focusing on marine/maritime technologies, life sciences and software development whose revenues will be used for the purpose of operating and maintaining the property located at 1213 Purchase Street.

The anticipated income from the tenants is expected to be approximately \$110,045 and the portion of gas & electric reimbursed from three of the tenants is anticipated to be an additional \$27,520 totaling \$137,565.00.

At this time I would like to request an FY 18 operating balance of \$137,565.00 which is the revenue that should be generated in FY18.
