



I am respectfully requesting that you recommend to City Council the appropriation of \$21,256.82 for the FY18 NB Energy Now (NBEN) Revolving fund.

This fund was developed to cover incidental costs of the energy residential outreach program and development. Currently, the Department of Public Infrastructure oversees the tracking of the fund.

Although FY17 revenue through June 30, 2017 is estimated to be \$0.00, the appropriation request amount is for the balance of revenue currently in the fund. FY17 expenses through June 30, 2017 are estimated to be \$251.28. FY18 expenses would be on an as needed basis.
