Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on Finance at a Meeting held on Monday, July 17, 2017, considered a WRITTEN MOTION, Councillor Morad, requesting, that the rental contract currently being negotiated with representatives of the Fort Taber Military Museum Association be presented to the Committee on Finance for review prior to being executed by the Administration; and further, that the Executive Board of the Fort Taber Military Museum Association, along with their legal representative be invited to the Committee on Finance to discuss the terms of the contract and the financial effect said contract will have on the future operation of the Military Museum.
