

Dear City Council,

The land located at 209 Theodore Rice Boulevard was recently purchased by New England Farms, Inc. 68 South Main Street, Assonet, MA. They are proposing to build a gas station and 4,500 square foot convenience store with a drive thru. They were recently approved by the Planning Board.

We wish to be heard by the City Council at the earliest meeting to obtain a License for the storage of 35,000 gallons of gasoline/diesel. The owner will install (2) two Underground Fuel Storage tanks; (1) one 20,000 gallon gasoline and (1) one 15,000 gallon compartmentalized tank (7K Super gasoline/8K diesel fuel). I have enclosed a copy of the Application for License signed by the local fire department Captain Charbonneau, (3) three 8 ½ x 11" Site Plans and (1) one copy of the Certified List of Abutters.
