





Subject: Considerations of approval to authorize Statements of Interest (SOI) for:

- Accelerated Repair Project for the Replacement of the John Avery Parker Roof
- Accelerated Repair Project for the Replacement of the Trinity Day Academy's boilers.



The Massachusetts School Building Authority requires each Statement of Interest that is submitted have proper vote documentation. All SOI's must be approved by a vote of the School Committee and a vote of the City Council.

During the recent upgrades made to comply with ADA regulations at the John Avery Parker Elementary School a new ventilation system was installed. When the contractor accessed the current roof conditions, it was found to have outlived its lifespan. A new roof is needed to support the new ventilation system to prevent leaks. We expect 80% reimbursement for this roof replacement.

The Accelerated Repair Project for the replacement of the Trinity Day Academy's boilers is needed because these boilers are original to the building and we no longer can get parts to repair them.

We can expect an 80% reimbursement for all work approved as part of these Statements of interest.


The vote was as follows:

- Priority 5: Replacement, renovation or modernization of school facility systems such as roofs, windows, boilers, heating and ventilation, to increase energy conservation and decrease energy related costs in a school facility.
- Deficiencies: The window/door systems in the building are original and are antiquated and require repair or replacement. The original boilers require replacement as they show signs of contamination and deterioration.




