The Southeastern Massachusetts Educational Collaborative (SMEC) has selected Michael Watson, a principal at GNBRVT to teach a Sheltered English Immersion (SEI) class for SMEC. In order for him to teach the SEI class on behalf of SMEC, Mr. Watson must file an ethics disclosure required by M.G.L. Ch. 268A § 20(b) with the member municipalities of GNBRVT. The disclosure must be approved by the Board of Selectmen for Dartmouth and Fairhaven and the New Bedford City Council.

Mr. Watson, via his disclosure, and SMEC, through its Executive Director, Catherine S. Cooper, Esq., have confirmed that all elements required by section 20(b) have been met, specifically:

- 1. Mr. Watson is not employed by SMEC and is not responsible for any activities of SMEC;
- 2. The list of teachers qualified to teach SEI from which Mr. Watson was selected was compiled via competitive RFP process;
- 3. Mr. Watson will be teaching outside of his normal working hours;

- 4. Mr. Watson's teaching services are not part of his regular duties as principal;
- 5. Mr. Watson's teaching services are not required for more than 500 hours per calendar year;
- 6. SMEC has filed a written certification with the City Clerk that no employee of SMEC is available to teach the SEI class as part of their regular duties.

I have reviewed the disclosure and its supporting documentation. Mr. Watson and SMEC have complied with all elements of the disclosure required by M.G.L. c. 268A § 20. The disclosure may be approved by City Council if it so chooses.

Dear Mr. Shreve:

Per our conversation this morning, I have enclosed a Ch. 268 §20(b) disclosure form highlighting the relationship between Mr. Watson, Greater New Bedford Regional Vocational Technical High School and SMEC.

I have also enclosed the list of instructors who have been qualified and approved by the MA Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) to provide Sheltered English Endorsement (SEI) courses. As I mentioned to you when we spoke, SMEC has been qualified as a provider for SEI courses through an RFP process and we have been requested by the DESE to provide these courses for local educators. We must only hire instructors from this list of qualified instructors, we do not have anyone on staff at SMEC who is an approved instructor nor can we hire anyone from the general public who is not on the DESE approved list. Mr. Watson is the only approved instructor who both lives locally and is available to teach courses at our Dartmouth location at night and on weekends. Mr. Watson will not provide more than 500 hours of work to SMEC during this year.
