Dear Mayor Mitchell,

I have been flying out of New Bedford Airport since 1996. The airport was a part of the decision for our family to relocate Brahmin Leather Works to the Greater New Bedford area at that time. To this day, our largest customers utilize New Bedford Airport to visit our corporate headquarters. I encourage you to protect this valuable resource, and to not let it diminish.

The proposed narrowing of Runway 14/32 would decrease the utility of the airport, especially in the winter months when snowbanks further reduce the width of the runways. While 14/32 is not served by a traditional Instrument Landing System (ILS), it is served by multiple GPS approaches. GPS approaches are the way of the future, and can already allow nearly the same ability to land in reduced ceilings/visibility as legacy ILSs.

I see this decision as being a crossroads. If we allow this narrowing to take place, it will never return. Please help to protect this infrastructure for our community.
