Attached, for your review, is correspondence related to the above referenced sewer abatement request.

The circumstances associated with this request have been investigated by the Department of Public Infrastructure, Wastewater Division. As a result of the investigation, the hose hideaway on the outside of the house became defective and started leaking water unbeknownst to the residents. This water seeped into the ground until it became saturated enough for it to leak through the foundation and into the basement. None of this water made its way back into the collection system. I would recommend that a credit of \$141.21 be allowed.

Should you be in agreement, I would ask that you communicate the abatement recommendation to the City Council.

Dear Mr. Ponte,

Last month my husband discovered some water in our basement coming from the front wall of our home. We panicked and called a contractor thinking we had a crack in our foundation. After careful inspection of the source of the leak he informed us it was coming from our water hose in the front of the house. We did not notice the hose was leaking because the leak was on the inside of the hose hideaway we have and was not visible to the eye. (see attached photo). There was no puddling of water near or around the hose hideaway at all. It sits on an area of thick mulch which must have absorbed any water visible but it apparently was leaking underneath into the basement. It had to be leaking for a month! Imagine my surprise when my water bill arrived at \$317.63 cents! Our usual water bill is between \$71.00 to \$92.00 monthly. All previous bills prior to July are paid in full. We only owe current charges of \$317.63 cents. My husband and I are both disabled and living on a fixed income. We have become responsible for raising our 3 teenaged grandchildren (8 yrs., now). You can imagine imagine how every penny is stretched to make ends meet.

I'm asking for your understanding about this water bill situation, I am just sick over it. Is there any way you could consider an abatement or reduce this bill to our usual amount we pay monthly ? I wouldn't even ask if there were any way we were able to work to make extra money. We would be grateful if you could as we are facing school clothes and supplies in the next few months which will deplete a lot of money from our budget and is always a rough time for us. Thank You for your time to read this long letter of explanation and for your consideration about this matter.
