Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on Finance at a Meeting held on Monday, March 11, 2019, considered a COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council, submitting a LOAN ORDER, in the amount of \$3,975,000.00 for the purpose of making critically-needed repairs to City-owned buildings including, but not limited to, projects for the repair and renovations of public safety facilities, recreational facilities, general office space, roads and infrastructure. (FY 2019-2023 Capital Improvement Program.) (Ref'd 12/13/18)

The Committee voted on the following:

NBHS Renovations in the amount of \$250,000, Passed, Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0; Buttonwood Park Zoo in the amount of \$700,000, Passed, Roll Call Vote Yeas 7, Nays 2; Merchant Mariners Memorial Walkway in the amount of \$200,000 Passed, Roll Call Vote Yeas 8, Nays 1; City Hall Deferred Maintenance in the amount of \$250,000, Passed, Roll Call Vote Yeas 6, Nays 3; Hillman Complex Continuation in the amount of \$500,000, Passed, Roll Call Vote Yeas 9, Nays 0; Police Headquarters Renovations in the amount of \$375,000, Tabled; Roads & Infrastructure in the amount of \$1,600,000, Passed, Roll Call Vote Yeas 9, Nays 0

On motion by Councillor Abreu and seconded by Councillor Coelho, the Committee VOTED: To recommend to the City Council ADOPTION of the LOAN ORDER, AS AMENDED, in the amount of \$3,500,000.00 for the purpose of making critically-needed repairs to City-owned buildings including, but not limited to, projects for the repair and renovations of public safety facilities, recreational facilities, general office space, roads and infrastructure. (FY 2019-2023 Capital Improvement Program.) This motion passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0..
