Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on Ordinance at a Meeting held on Tuesday, March 12, 2019, considered a COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, submitting THREE ORDINANCES, amending Chapter 12 Health and Sanitation, Section 12-39.5 Unattended Clothing Donation Containers, amending Chapter 17, Section 17-8 Noncriminal Disposition of violations of certain Ordinances, rules and regulations and amending Chapter 17, Section 17-28 Chapter 40U of the Massachusetts General Laws. (Ref'd 10/25/18)

On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Morad, the Committee VOTED: To amend Section 12-39.5 Unattended Clothing Donation Containers under section (C) under PROHIBITIONS, number three (3) by striking "occupied residential unit, or other ongoing activity." This motion passed on a voice vote.

On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Morad, the Committee VOTED: To amend Section 12-39.5 Unattended Clothing Donation Containers, on section (E) under APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS, number seven (7) Change "1,000 feet to 5,000 feet." This motion passed on a voice vote.

On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Giesta, the Committee VOTED: To amend Section 12-39.5 Unattended Clothing Donation Containers, on section (E) under APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS, number eight (8) add letter "f. Submit site plan of where cameras will be placed." This motion passed on a voice vote with Councillor Morad opposed.

On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Giesta, the Committee VOTED: To recommend to the City Council ADOPTION AS AMENDED, AN ORDINANCE, amending Chapter 12 Health and Sanitation, Section 12-39.5 Unattended Clothing Donation Containers. This motion passed on a voice vote.
