Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on City Property at a Meeting held on Tuesday, October 22, 2019, considered a COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council, submitting TWO ORDERS, the first Order declares the former Kempton School surplus property and transfer it from the School Committee to the Committee on City Property; and the second Order authorizes the Mayor to execute a deed transferring the Kempton School to the Alma del Mar Charter School, contingent upon the State Legislature passing the Home Rule Petition. On motion by Councillor Lima and seconded by Councillor Markey, the Committee VOTED: To recommend to the City Council to take "No Further Action" on the COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council, submitting TWO ORDERS, the first Order declares the former Kempton School surplus property and transfer it from the School Committee to the Committee on City Property; and the second Order authorizes the Mayor to execute a deed transferring the Kempton School to the Alma del Mar Charter School, contingent upon the State Legislature passing the Home Rule Petition.
