

I have attached correspondence to support the reason for this request.

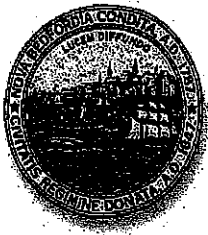
