SECTION 1.

Chapter 10, Finance; Taxation; Property, is hereby amended by striking the Revolving Fund entitled "Fines/Forfeitures Revolving Fund" from the table included in Sec. 10-47 Departmental revolving funds, subsection (e) and inserting the following at the end of the table included in Sec. 10-47. Subject: Health Department Revolving Fund Account

The New Bedford Health Department is exploring ways to make the City of New Bedford the healthiest city in the state. The health department is faced with addressing population health concerns which often deplete department resources and finances. The intent of the Health Department programs revolving fund account is to provide financial resources to address the need for episodic and routine public health investigations and evaluations that further prevent the spread of chronic, communicable and infectious disease. The health department is requesting an amendment to revolving fund account 1204 in accordance with DEPARTMENTAL REVOLVING FUND General Laws Chapter 44, § 53E^{1/2}. The Fines and Forfeiture Revolving Fund-1204 was originally designated to receive fines from lead violations. We no longer enforce the lead poisoned child provisions of the lead law and therefore have no legal recourse to retain these funds to support the account. These services are currently being provided by the Massachusetts Department of Public Health, Childhood Lead Poison Prevention Program (CLPPP). The revenue source for this account going forward will be supported by fines collected throughout the year in accordance with our Environmental Health Code Enforcement requirements.
