Dear Council President Lopes and Honorable Members of the City Council:

Attached for the Council's consideration are proposed amendments to Chapter 9, Section 1200 of the City's Code of Ordinances, clarifying the definition of seafood processing and light manufacturing, and adding a definition for seafood products, consistent with the proposed amended definitions.

The Code's definitions for seafood processing were established in 2003 to help address concerns that potential fish waste odors produced during traditional seafood processing operations could negatively impact nearby properties. Over the last seventeen years, however, the technology and methods of seafood processing have evolved dramatically, such that, today, certain types of operations no longer produce the waste (and consequently, the related odors) which were of concern in the past.

The proposed amendments seek to update the definition of seafood processing to reflect changes in technology and methods, so that the City can continue to restrict operations that may produce objectionable waste odors, while permitting the appropriate siting of operations that do not generated these impacts.

The proposed definitional change has been made in close consultation with the New Bedford Port Authority. In recent years, the Port has seen sustained, significant growth in the processing sector as other East Coast ports continue to relocate processing operations to New Bedford, and local processors expand their operations. The proposed changes will ensure that the Port maximizes its opportunities to take advantage of these industry trends, and stays competitive in the years ahead.
