Amending Chapter 10. Finance; Taxation; Property

31- 509

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of New Bedford as follows:—

SECTION 1.

Chapter 10, Finance; Taxation; Property. Sec. 10-47 – Departmental revolving funds, subsection (c) table is hereby amended by inserting “facility improvements to the McCoy Gym and capital expenses” into the Revolving Fund entitled “Supportive Recreation Revolving Fund” under “Program or Activity Expenses Payable from Fund (iv)”, to read as follows:

Revolving Fund (i)	Department, Board, Committee, Agency or Officer Authorized to Spend from Fund (ii)	Fees, Charges or Other Receipts Credited to Fund (iii)	Program or Activity Expenses Payable from Fund (iv)	Restrictions or Conditions on Expenses Payable from Fund (v)	Other Requirements/ Reports (vi)	Fiscal Years (vii)
Supportive Recreation Revolving Fund	Department of Parks Recreation and Beaches	Program and application fees	Program instructors, program supplies, facility improvements to the McCoy Gym and capital expenses			Fiscal Year 2018 and subsequent years

Section 2.

This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43 of the General Laws.
