AN ORDINANCE

RELATIVE TO EMPLOYEE RESIDENCY

31- 509

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of New Bedford as follows:---

SECTION 1.

Article II of Chapter 19 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by striking Sections 19-20 through 19-27 in their entirety.

SECTION 2. Article II of Chapter 19 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby further amended by inserting the following Section :-

19-20 Residency of Members of Board and Commissions.

Every person appointed, reappointed, re-elected or reselected to serve on any Authority, Advisory Board, Board, Commission or Committees, whether such service is compensated or not, shall be a resident of the City and shall not cease to be a resident of the City during the term for which said person was appointed, reappointed, re-elected or reselected unless the Mayor requests a Waiver by submitting such request to the City Council and the City Council approves the waiver by 2/3 vote after determining that such a waiver for the particular individual is in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 3. Section 2-121 of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances is herby amended by striking the last sentence of said Section.

SECTION 4. Section 23-1 of Chapter 23 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by striking the first sentence and inserting, in place thereof, the following sentence:-

"The Mayor with the approval of the City Council may appoint a Parking Supervisor."

SECTION 5. Paragraph (a) of Section 2-47 of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by striking the following words of said Section:-

"shall be subject to residency requirement under Chapter 19, Article II."

SECTION 6. Section 2-237 of Chapter 2 of Article XXII of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by striking the last sentence of said Section.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43 of the General Laws.
