Buttonwood Park Stormwater Management for \$67,800, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0.

Capitol Theatre Renovations for \$200,000, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0.

Digitization of Maritime Records/Whaling Logbooks for \$10,000, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 2, with Councillors Baptiste and Morad opposed.

Digitization of Milton Silva Negative Collection for \$20,000, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 2, with Councillor Baptiste and Morad opposed.

First Baptist Church/Steeple Playhouse for \$56,900, Passed on Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0.

Gilbert Russell House Restoration for \$175,000, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 8, Nays 1, with Councillor Morad opposed.

Hazelwood Park Bowling Green for \$50,000, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0.

Hillman Street Firehouse Lofts Restoration for \$300,000, Passed on a Roll Call Voter of Yeas 8, Nays 1, with Councillor Morad opposed.

Temple Landing II for \$181,811, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0.

Verdean Vets Memorial Hall for \$55,000, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0.

West Beach Bathhouse Renovation for \$29,500, Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 0.

On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Coelho, the Committee VOTED: To recommend to the City Council APPROVAL of the Community Preservation Act Funding Recommendations for eleven (11) Projects totaling \$1,145,011.00. This motion passed on voice vote.
