I am respectfully requesting that you recommend to City Council the appropriation of \$20,683.22 for the FY20 NB Energy Now (NBEN) Revolving Fund 1251.

This fund was developed to cover incidental costs of the energy residential outreach program and development. Currently, the Department of Public Infrastructure oversees the tracking of the fund.

FY20 revenue through June 30, 2021 is estimated to be approximately \$7,000.00. FY20 expenses through June 30, 2021 are estimated to be \$7,500.00. FY20 expenses would be on an as-needed basis for advertising, employee training, marketing materials, and other related expenses.
