Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on Appointments & Briefings at a Meeting held on Tuesday, March 16, 2021, considered a COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council submitting AN ORDER that the City waives the appraisal requirement and the right to any damages the City may be entitled to with respect to one permanent easement and one temporary easement to be acquired for the Hathaway Road Triangle Improvement Project and further authorizing the Mayor to execute on behalf of the City of New Bedford a Certificate of Donation Form for easement E-1 and Right of Way Entry – Without Prejudice Form for temporary easement TE-4. On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Gomes, the Committee VOTED: To recommend to the City Council to take "No Further Action" on the COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council submitting AN ORDER that the City waives the appraisal requirement and the right to any damages the City may be entitled to with respect to one permanent easement and one temporary easement to be acquired for the Hathaway Road Triangle Improvement Project and further authorizing the Mayor to execute on behalf of the City of New Bedford a Certificate of Donation Form for easement E-1 and Right of Way Entry — Without Prejudice Form for temporary easement TE-4. ORDERED that, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 79, § 7A, the City of New Bedford hereby waives the appraisal requirement and the right to any damages the City may be entitled to with respect to one permanent easement and one temporary easement, to be acquired for the Hathaway Road Triangle Improvements Project, and further authorizing the Mayor to execute, on behalf of the City of New Bedford, a Certificate of Donation form for easement E-1 and a Right of Entry — Without Prejudice form for temporary easement TE-4 (copies attached).

The proposed easements, on City owned property, are located on the triangular shaped parcel abutting Hathaway Road, Nauset Street and Mount Pleasant Street, upon which the Franco American Veterans' Memorial is located, shown on City of New Bedford Assessor's Map 101 as Lot 7.
