Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on Finance at a Meeting held on Wednesday, April 14, 2021, considered a COMMUNICATION, Mayor Mitchell, to City Council submitting an Order authorizing the City to enter into a five-year capital lease purchase agreement for replacement vehicles assigned to the Departments of Facilities and Fleet Management and the Fire Department. (Ref'd 03/25/2021)

On motion by Councillor Lopes and seconded by Councillor Markey, the Committee VOTED: To recommend to the City Council ADOPTION of AN ORDER, authorizing the City to enter into a five-year capital lease purchase agreement for replacement vehicles assigned to the Departments of Facilities and Fleet Management and the Fire Department in the amount of \$1,853,076 (1,087,050 from the General Fund and \$766,026 from Wastewater Fund).
