The program and purpose of the fund "whose purpose is to cover improvements to Fort Taber Park and associated buildings and structures, seasonal staff for parking and park programs and supplies associated with programs, whose revenues and amount limited to be spent for FY22 is restricted to revenue deposited into the fund."

Estimated revenues \$55,000

Revenue source(s) fees from facility rentals, seasonal beach parking, programs and park use fees generated at Fort Taber Park and associated buildings

Amount estimated to be expended in FY22 \$80,000 of which \$25,000, (twenty-five thousand dollars) is a portion of the undesignated fund balance.

The requested \$80,000 will cover Fort Taber Park daily operations and the following improvements to East Beach and Fort Taber Park:

- Installation of a security gate at the middle East Beach parking lot and replacement of damaged picnic tables at Fort Taber Park.
