

Re: Departmental Transfer Request

I am requesting a transfer of \$100,000 from EMS Salaries and Wages account to EMS Charges and Services account and EMS Supplies and Materials account.

The surplus in my 100 account is due to the City capturing reimbursements through CARES for covidrelated expenses in EMS during the pandemic.

The deficit in the 200 is mostly due to Comstar and increased ambulance runs which has resulted in increased payments to our billing vendor as well as an unbudgeted judgment (\$33k) that was paid out this year.

The deficit in the 400 account is mostly due to increased cost and demand of medical supplies for the department.

For these reasons, I am requesting that \$60,000 be transferred into my 200 account and \$40,000 into my 400 account to cover the projected deficits.
