Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on Finance at a Meeting held on Monday, May 09, 2022, considered a REPORT, Committee on Finance, recommending to the City Council ADOPTION of the ORDER, for the Community Preservation Act FY22 Funding Recommendations for fifteen (15) Projects totaling \$1,412,500.00 (Ref'd 04/12/2022); and a COMMUNICATION, Janine da Silva, Chair, Community Preservation Committee, submitting for reconsideration of the City Council, the CPA Project: New Bedford Whaling Museum Bourne Masonry Repair;(Ref'd 04/28/2022)

On motion by Councillor Morad and seconded by Councillor Pereira, the Committee VOTED: To remove item two (2) City Wide Signage for Parks for \$24,000 from the Community Preservation Act FY22 Funding Recommendations. This motion FAILED on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 5, Nays 6, with Councillors Carney, Giesta, Gomes, Morad and Pereira in favor.

On motion by Councillor Dunn and seconded by Councillor Pereira, the Committee VOTED: To restore CPA Project, New Bedford Whaling Museum Bourne Masonry Repair for \$187,500. This motion passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 4, with Councillors Giesta, Gomes, Morad and Pereira opposed.

On motion by Councillor Morad and seconded by Councillor Lima, the Committee VOTED: To recommend that the City Council Amend the Order for the Community Preservation Act FY22 Projects funding amount from \$1,412,500 to \$1,600,000. This motion passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 9, Nays 2, with Councillors Morad and Pereira opposed.
