AN ORDINANCE

Amending Chapter 10, Article I - In General

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of New Bedford as follows:—

SECTION 1. Chapter 10, Article I, Section 10-43, is hereby amended by striking the phrase "human relations commission" and replacing it with "human rights commission" so the amended section reads as follows:

Sec. 10-43. - City vehicles - Lettering.

All motor vehicles now owned, and subsequently acquired by the city, except certain police vehicles at the discretion of the chief of police, and except the car assigned to the human rights commission, shall be clearly identified as city property by having painted on the panels of the two (2) front doors, in legible type in letters at least two (2) inches high and in colors contrasting to that of the car, the following:

"CITY OF NEW BEDFORD

(Department or official having charge of car)"

Said lettering is to be done within ten (10) days of acquisition of the vehicle.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43 of the General Laws.
