SUBSTITUTE MOTION

Ordered, that, relative to the proposed construction of a new or reconstructed DeValles School on its present site or as expanded to the north by the acquisition of six (6) parcels bordered by Rivet, Orchard, Bonney and Katherine Streets, *and/or the former Goodyear property on the west side of Orchard Street, New Bedford Assessor's Map 23, Lot 158*, the City Council determines pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 30B, Section 16 (e)(2) that advertising will not benefit the governmental body's interest because of the unique qualities or location of property needed. The property proposed for acquisition is unique as it is exactly adjacent to the DeVales School, therefore, the City Council waives the advertising pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 30B, Section 16 (e) (2).
