
RE: Amendment to City Ordinance, Chapter 10, Amending a Revolving Fund

AN ORDINANCE

Amending Chapter 10, Finance; Taxation; Property

31- 509

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of New Bedford as follows:—

SECTION 1. Chapter 10, Finance; Taxation; Property, Article I, Section 10-47, Departmental revolving funds, is hereby amended by adding the Police Department to the list of Departments authorized to spend from the Tangible Supply Disposition Revolving Fund, so that the “Tangible Supply Disposition Revolving Fund” row in the table included below Section 10-47(e) reads as follows:

Section 2.

This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 43 of the General Laws.
