The Committee on Ordinances, at a meeting held on Tuesday, April 11, 2023, considered AN ORDINANCE, amending Chapter 17, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, subjecting violators of Chapter 12, Section 12-41.1 – Duty of Property Owners to Maintain Yard and Adjacent Areas to a graduated fine regime, and adding the offenses and associated fines to Section 17-18, Noncriminal Disposition of Violations of Certain Ordinances, Rules and Regulations; AND, Section 17-28, Chapter 40U of the Massachusetts General Laws. (Ref'd 10/14/2021) and a Report recommending Adoption of said Ordinance - April 08, 2021.) (Ref'd 10/14/2021)

On motion by Councillor Giesta and seconded by Councillor Morad, the Committee VOTED: To recommend that the City Council take "NO FURTHER ACTION" on the ORDINANCE, amending Chapter 17, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, subjecting violators of Chapter 12, Section 12-41.1 – Duty of Property Owners to Maintain Yard and Adjacent Areas to a graduated fine regime, and adding the offenses and associated fines to Section 17-18, Noncriminal Disposition of Violations of Certain Ordinances, Rules and Regulations; AND, Section 17-28, Chapter 40U of the Massachusetts General Laws, and the REPORT recommending Adoption of said Ordinance.)
