On a motion by Councillor Carney, and seconded by Councillor Pereira, the Committee VOTED: to approve \$47,167.00 for the Boys and Girls Club Playground. Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 0.

On a motion by Councillor Pereira and seconded by Councillor Giesta, the Committee VOTED: to approve \$270,827.00 for the Capitol Theater. Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 0.

On a motion by Councillor Carney and seconded by Councillor Pereira, the Committee VOTED: to approve \$48,000.00 for the Rotch-Jones-Duff House Rubber Roof Repair. Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 0.

On a motion by Councillor Pereira and seconded by Councillor Carney, the Committee VOTED: to approve \$48,000.00 for the Rural Cemetery Gravestone Conservation. Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 0.

On a motion by Councillor Baptiste and seconded by Councillor Oliver, the Committee VOTED: to approve \$250,000.00 for the Sgt. William H. Carney Academy Community Playground. Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 6, Nays 0.

On a motion by Councillor Oliver and seconded by Councillor Baptiste, the Committee VOTED: to approve \$27,500.00 for the Sgt. William H. Carney House Front Porch Rehabilitation. Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 0.

On a motion by Councillor Giesta and seconded by Councillor Oliver, the Committee VOTED: to approve \$240,000.00 for the Strand Theater Restoration. Passed on a Roll Call Vote of Yeas 7, Nays 0.
