Dear Honorable Members of the City Council:

The Committee on City Property at a Meeting held on Wednesday, June 21, 2023, considered a WRITTEN MOTION, Councillors Baptiste and Abreu, requesting, on behalf of D.F. Pray, General Contractors, that the following streets be CLOSED: A PORTION OF COMMERCIAL STREET, Starting 161' from the NORTH most point and 172' from the SOUTH most point at the Intersection with SOUTH WATER STREET, to its terminus, and including portions of the sidewalks immediately adjacent to the three buildings on their SOUTH AND EAST elevations, FROM AUGUST 01, 2023 TO DECEMBER 31, 2023, (PLEASE NOTE: A Five-Month Extension of Current Street Closing Which Will Expire on July 31, 2023) for the purpose of a construction project at 21-35 Commercial Street, 13-19 Commercial Street and 24 Union Street. (Ref'd 06/08/2023)

On motion by Councillor Morad and seconded by Councillor Carney, the Committee VOTED: To recommend that the City Council GRANT the Street Closing: A PORTION OF COMMERCIAL STREET, Starting 161' from the NORTH most point and 172' from the SOUTH most point at the Intersection with SOUTH WATER STREET, to its terminus, and including portions of the sidewalks immediately adjacent to the three buildings on their SOUTH AND EAST elevations, FROM AUGUST 01, 2023 TO DECEMBER 31, 2023, (PLEASE NOTE: A Five-Month Extension of Current Street Closing Which Will Expire on July 31, 2023) for the purpose of a construction project at 21-35 Commercial Street, 13-19 Commercial Street and 24 Union Street. This motion passed on a voice vote.
