RESOLUTION HONORING THE TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE MUSEUM OF MADEIRAN HERITAGE

WHEREAS, In 1998, after years of neglect, a derelict building and its surrounding grounds were beautifully restored, almost entirely with volunteer labor and funding from the Clube Madeirense S.S. Sacramento and many generous donations of in-kind services from the local community; and,

WHEREAS, The Museum of Madeiran Heritage was dedicated in July of 1999 and is currently the only museum dedicated to the Madeiran culture and heritage; and,

WHEREAS, The Museum of Madeiran Heritage is a repository of life in Madeira, displaying cultural artifacts from the Island which include collections of art, fine crafts, embroidery, lace, linens, pottery, waving, traditional folkloric dancer costumes for visitors to enjoy, and even an authentic "corea" – a sled used to transport visitors from the village of Monte high atop a hill outside of Funchal, the capital city of Madeira; and

WHEREAS, On the northside of the museum is the beautiful Madeira Garden, with a fountain, grape arbor and plantings that surround the lawn and are truly reminiscent of the wonderful gardens that can be typically found in many Madeiran villages; and

WHEREAS, The Museum of Madeiran Heritage also houses Madeiran-American artifacts and items related to the history of the Feast of the Blessed Sacrament, and collaborations have led to the publication of several books on Madeiran Culture; and

WHEREAS, the Museum of Madeiran Heritage is managed and staffed by an all-volunteer committee, a standing committee of the Clube Madeirense S.S. Sacramento, sponsors of the annual Feast of the Blessed Sacrament, which to this day remains the largest Portuguese feast in the world; and

WHEREAS, Tours of students ranging in age from elementary school through post-graduate programs have been hosted, and are promoted throughout the region and as far away as Canada; and

WHEREAS, Admission to the Museum of Madeiran Heritage has always been free of charge:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the New Bedford City Council hereby honors THE TWENTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE MUSEUM OF MADEIRAN HERITAGE, thanks its members, staff and volunteers for their dedication to the Madeiran culture and wishes them and the Museum many more years of success.
