(CABH)** a Massachusetts non-profit corporation existing in accordance with 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, having an address at 72 Eighth Street, New Bedford, Massachusetts 02740 (hereinafter called the "Grantee"), without covenants express or implied, as appurtenant to land owned by Grantee in New Bedford, Bristol County, Massachusetts, a parking easement, described as follows:




